

***Heath Township
Meeting Minutes
May 2021***

1. Call to order

The regular monthly meeting of the Heath Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Ron Jones at 7:00 p.m. on May 10 at the Township Hall. Bill opened with prayer.

2. Roll call

3. Approval of minutes from last meeting

- a) Jim Storey, County Commissioner gave his monthly report:

- c) Culvert Replacement on 42nd St. south of 134th Ave.- cost is \$22,000. Motion made by Boerman and supported by M.Harvey. Unanimously approved. Motions passed.
- d) Motion by Boerman and supported by B.Harvey to appoint Kirk VanOrder to a 3 year term to expire on May 30, 2024 to the Board of Review. Unanimously approved. Motion passed.
- e) Boerman stated that Township clean up day on May 8 went well. Filled up 15 dumpsters.

5. New business

- f) Eric Hoffman – resident – was asking about outbuilding sizes and the formula used. He is going to attend the planning commission meeting to look into this further.
- g) Matthew O'Brien – resident – was asking for the Township to continue working on the Fireworks Ordinance for Heath Township. One has been sent by the attorney to the Fire Chief. The Board is waiting to hear back from the Chief
